# How to make an inexpensive Stripping Basket

#### Materials

1 IKEA Children's Footstool 4.99

8 Stainless Steel 10x1 pan head screws 16 cents ea.



8 14-16 x 1 3/8 Plastic wall anchors 6 cents each



1 Wading Belt (Bass Pro Shop) \$5.99

Total Price - \$12.74 + Tax






#### Tools

- Electric Drill
- ¼ inch drill bit
- 1/8 inch drill bit
- Phillips head screw driver
- Pliers
- Utility Knife


### **Invert Footstool**



### Drill two ¼ inch drain holes on each side of reinforcements



### Drill eight 1/8 inch holes on bottom



### Insert screws from bottom




### Insert plastic wall anchors over screws


(you might want to put a dab of Gorilla Glue inside each anchor)




# Make sure the screw is flush to the bottom



## Drill two ¼ inch holes in the narrow end corners



### Make sure holes are in the upper part of the basket and are far enough apart for your wading belt



### Carefully, using a utility knife, clean out the space between the holes (heating the knife up makes the job a little easier)



## Make sure the slots are somewhat even
