



Deschutes River Steelhead – Spey Water Camp

The World famous Deschutes River is second to none in steelhead fly fishing. This river is a gem in the high desert of central Oregon. Flowing north to the Columbia River the Deschutes River is home to one of the most robust summer and fall steelhead runs in the lower 48. Aggressive steelhead caught on swung fly are the hallmark of the Deschutes. Most of the season steelhead can be caught on floating lines. This technique is thrilling and rewarding. Mid-day fishing with sink tips can also yield results. Steelhead are a prized fish and tough to catch, we work hard to put the odds in your favor.

During the summer and fall timeframe Steelhead fly fishing is best morning and evening. We focus on getting our clients optimal time on the best water. This time of year the days are long and we often are on the river starting at sun-up to give you the best opportunity at steelhead and our camps are often on *the* prime water.

Fishing Dates: **Aug 15 & 16**

Where: Deschutes River Canyon

What: Wild and Hatchery Steelhead

How: Swung flies – spey rods are ideal

Meeting place: Mack’s Canyon boat ramp. This is located downstream of Maupin and 22 miles upstream from the mouth of the river. This is the most remote part of the lower river. The jet boat allows us flexibility and options to move up and down the river to find the fish.

Meeting time: 5:30 pm at the boat ramp. We will also wrap up by 5 pm the following day. Camping is available at Macks Canyon. In Maupin we recommend the Imperial Inn 800-395-3903.

Fee: The regular rate for overnight trips is \$350 per person. Just for your club we are offering a special rate of \$200 per person (that is only \$25 more than last year and we didn’t offer the camp). This would include a light breakfast, big BBQ shore lunch, guide secret flies and rods as needed. Of course you know that is a very long day on the water so folks will definitely get their money’s worth. Each day we can take up to 3 anglers.
